The festival is open to the public free of charge and is a great way to learn more about 4-H.

The Cultural Arts Festival provides 4-H members an opportunity to showcase their talents in music, drama, speech, art, photography, reading and writing. A recent statewide study found that children who participate in 4-H arts and communications projects gain important technical, communication and teamwork skills, while increasing their self-esteem and self-confidence. The surveyed children reported that 4-H helped them improve their individual performance and creativity skills, build good learning habits as they integrated feedback from judges and other experts, and bolstered their opportunities to become confident public speakers.
